### A Magician's Philosophy "Connection 3 DVD set" Reviewed by Joel A Moskowitz M D December 19, 2013

Whats the most important letter of the alphabet? Jon Allen says Y. Or why? In 6.5 hrs, with 23 effects, this thinking magician stresses the value of not having spectators or audiences but involved partners in the phenomenon of magical entertainment. This three DVD set named CONNECTION is a Penguin Magic offering.

He eschews having magic miracle with no point. In conjoint discussions with Dan Harlan, he explains why he believes knowing the why of every aspect of the magical performance is better. Contrast with just juggling the cards, coins, ropes, rings, rubber bands and striving to induce a weary appreciation in spectator.

DFKDFC is an abbreviated Jon Allen theme: DFKDFC ( Don't \$%# Know, Don't \$%# Care )

Allen emphasizes the necessity of shunning the passive spectator who is frequently disinterested in the intrusive walk about magish. First priority is not to do tricks but find out about the spectators and make them care. Thereby you achieve a CONNECTION, hence the name of this three DVD offering.

Not only a psychology discourse, Jon Allen instructs the viewer how he maximizes effects. For example, in his High Society he gives his method for throwing and attaching the card to the ceiling. This is a practiced performer giving his tried and true methods for doing known effects.

"How do you know to set the level of connection?" asks Dan Harlan. Allens response, "It took me nine years to find an opening line. 'Are you a fun table?' Should one person say, No thank you. I wanted to entertain you but one vetoed it. One was against it, is that the vote for you all?" By this strategy, you will determine if they are interested and not experience your performance as an invasion. Dan Harlan praises You are connecting on a human level.

Allen searches for Creativity. He thinks, "Wouldn't it be good, if.... " Magicians are limited to the physical world but that shouldn't block you from invention. If it aunt broke....break it! Can you



conceive where we would be if black TV is good enough. The three excellently filmed DVDs will give you multiple examples of Jon Allens wonderment.


In his display of card to box (named Destination Box), he inquires "Who is the most trusted person?" If

someone exclaims "Me", he says that he never trusts a person who volunteers. The audience involvement often leads to them entertaining themselves - not just passively watching. Sometimes, Allen predicts, they can provide the best lines.

Not a graduate psychologist or psychiatrist, Jon Allens educated attention to subtle behavioral elements increases audience appreciation of his intriguing illusions. His aptitude of manipulating peoples expectations, misdirecting their attention and influencing their decision making maximizes their enjoyment.

Jon Allen demonstrates his art on stage, on the street and close up, The DVD student will have an ample selection of a variety of effects and the actual reactions of connected real people. The viewer will be fascinated by the novel intelligence. This reviewer predicts you would like to have a mentor such as Jon Allen. The discourse with Dan Harlan, in his own right, master of creativity, is flavoring to the feast. He gives you 6.5 hours of his/your time but you will thirst for more. What follows is a selection of the menu

To become a good teacher one first must be a good student. Steve Reynolds has spent over twenty years diligently studying the art of close-up magic.
