



His set of 4 DVDs are circa in sum some 200 minutes. If you will study these, you may spend many hours of viewing, practice. Probably the author/teacher/performer (Karl Hein) has devoted many years to perfect his art. He is to be complimented that he obsessively attended to clear instruction.

He holds nothing back: instruction is thorough but lightening. Even though the DVD is only some 20 minutes, you will watch it again and again.

"Godfrey the Magician practiced his chain escape in the back of the room at the club meeting on May 12th. Mike Stilwell and Joe Mystic secured Godfrey in the chains and locks. Godfrey will be performing the escape at the San Diego County Fair. There is 50 feet of chain and 13 locks. It totals a weight of 38 pounds.

You can see Godfrey the Magician perform this escape everyday at the San Diego County Fair June 7th to July 8th. His shows are located at the Fab Fun Stage in the infield. Show times are at 12:00, 2:30, and 4:30. Each show is about 30 minutes long. You can also see Godfrey entertain with close-up magic outside the main gate 30 minutes before the fair opens.


