

Minutes of the July 24, 2017
Board Meeting



The meeting was called to order by President Joe "Mystic" McGrievy at 7:24 pm (dinner started at 7:00pm). Present were First V.P. of Entertainment Richard Ustick, Second V.P. of Membership James Thayer, Secretary Ken Intriligator, Treasurer Bob Meigs, Sergeant-of-Arms John Hunter, Member-at-Large and Newsletter Editor Malcolm Campbell, and Member-at-Large Robert Vinson. Past board member Sherry Luft was also present. Member-at-Large (Past President and current librarian) Kenny Shelton and Member-at-Large Loch David Crane were absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the June Board meeting were approved.

REPORTS

<u>Treasurer's report</u> - Treasurer **Bob Meigs** presented his report to the board. There was a net reduction in the cash balance, primarily due to fees for the incorporation process and a net loss for the banquet. The report was approved by the board.

Library Report - None.

<u>Membership report</u> - James Thayer reported that the Ring now has 54 members in good standing,including 11 Life Members. This is down from 68 at this time last year.

<u>Installation Banquet report</u> - The banquet was a great success - one of the best! Everyone enjoyed the food, entertainment, and all other aspects. It sets a high bar to match or top in the future.

OLD BUSINESS

Ring incorporation - Malcolm updated us on the progress on getting the ring incorporated as a 501c6. The application is with the Secretary of State office and will eventually go to the IRS for Non-Profit status approval (where it could take up to a year). There will be additional fees throughout the process.

Officers in the future will have to provide some paperwork (a listing of the current officers) every other year to maintain the corporation status.

NEW BUSINESS

Next year's meetings - August 7, 2017: Bag Magic, September: No Theme performance night, October: Halloween Magic, November: Auction, December: Holiday pot-luck banquet, January: New-to-Me Magic, February: Close-Up Competition, March: No Theme performance night, April: Teach a Trick, May: Stand up Competition, June: No Theme performance night, July: Installation Banquet, August: (2018) Kid's Magic.

<u>Membership</u> - There was some preliminary discussion about programs to make Ring 76 more visible within the San Diego magic community and to attract new members —especially young magicians.

The board meeting adjourned at 8:43 pm.
