

#### GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Monday December 9, 2019

North Clairemont Recreation Center

This month's meeting was our December Holiday Potluck Banquet, and the food was plentiful and delicious (some favorites include **Terry Lunceford's** roast beef, **Mark Booth's** chili, **Miguel Garcia's** BBQ'd tri-tip steak, and Ricardo Silva's tamales). Pre-meeting, the food serving stations were set up, tickets were sold for an opportunity drawing, and members and their guests socialized.

President **Richard Ustick** called the meeting to order at 7pm with a few announcements, including about the evening's food and entertainment, and he noted that the January 13, 2020 meeting theme of "food magic" will be replaced with a lecture by Danny Ray.

#### **ENTERTAINMENT PERFORMANCES**

Vice President for Entertainment **Greg Wauson** was the master-of -ceremonies for the entertainment, starting at 7:45. He explained the "You Fooled Us" concept of the night's performances, and noted the several crucial differences distinguishing ours from a certain show on TV. **Terry Lunceford** and **Robert Vinson** were our judges, and **Jeff Marcus** was the arbiter who would decide if partial solutions were sufficient. Fooling performances would earn a beautiful plaque, that will be hand-crafted by Librarian **Gary Salisbury**. The plaques will be presented at the January 13, 2020 ring meeting.

The first performance was by Malcolm Campbell, who Greg noted had as a child seen Harry Blackstone Sr. perform, including his famed illusion of sawing a woman in half. Malcolm was assisted by Eli Sanchez, who was asked to inspect a small lock and try to open it with a random 4 digit number. Eli confirmed that it did not open for the random number, or for a second random one. When set to the month and day of Eli's birthday, however, the lock opened! The judges offered a partial solution, but Jeff deemed it to be insufficient. Congratulations, Malcolm - this was a fooler!

Next was **Charlie Gott** who performs Gospel Magic. Charlie did a coin routine, with the coin representing a lost soul. It's good to see you performing again, Charlie. Terry provided a detailed explanation, so this was not a fooler.

Next was Mark Booth (who is Ring 76's Committee Chair for Social Media Communication). Mark was assisted by Marieke Thayer and Ian Gibbons. The effect used cards that each had three digit numbers on them, which were first dealt into five piles, each of which had six cards. Marieke was asked to shuffle each pile, and then turn over the top card. Mark immediately announced the sum of the five three-digit numbers, and had Ian verify using a calculator that Mark got the total correct. Next Marieke was asked to pick one card from each pile, and Mark again immediately announced the correct total. Next, cards were removed and then Mark knew the number of remaining cards, and he called the number on each of the remaining cards, as well as their total. The judges revealed enough to determine that this was

not a fooler (though Mark noted that the correct explanation was perhaps easier than the judges made it seem, and Jeff Marcus agreed with a humorous line).

The next performance was by Board Member-at-Large **Rich Robertson**. Rich also demonstrated lightning-fast addition, with the assistance of Secretary **Ken Intriligator** and **Gary Dismukes** checking with some jumbo calculators that Rich provided. Audience members were asked to provide three-digit numbers, which Rich instantly added. Then the numbers were used to compute a total, which was then demonstrated to have been already written on a piece of paper in a sealed envelope. Congratulations, Rich - this was a fooler!

The next performance was by **Bob Meigs**, with judges Robert and Terry, and MC Greg, as assistants. The four of them each took four cards, which were torn in half. The 8 pieces were permuted, with one half-card stepped on and others gradually discarded. At the end of the instructions, it was found that the remaining, non-discarded card matched the one that had been stepped on. It was not a fooler, and Bob explained afterwards to all the details of how it works.

The next performance was by Newsletter editor **Winton Gibbons**, assisted by **Miguel Garcia** and **Rich Robertson**. The performance was a tale of time and space, with a handkerchief representing the fabric of space-time, and a large blanket pin was inserted to represent singularities (black holes, big bang, etc.). The assistants verified that everything looked legit, and then Winton poked the pin through the hank and pulled it through several times, and to a general location, and the fabric of space-time hank was completely unharmed. It was a great performance, Winton, and I liked the science theme! The judges gave a hint of the explanation, and it was deemed to be not a fooler.

The next performance was by **Eli Sanchez**, who was assisted by **Raul**, the son of **Mago Ruly**. A selection of movie DVD cases was shown to Raul, and a blank DVD was put into a blank DVD case. Raul was asked to select one of the film DVD cases by saying stop. Then the blank DVD case was opened and the previously blank DVD now matched the selected film. It was a great performance, Eli! The judges gave a hint of the explanation, and it was not a fooler.

The final performance was by Mago Ruly, assisted by his son Raul and Ian Gibbons. Raul noted that Mago was practicing the effect on their recent trip from Cancun to Tijuana. The effect was with cards, taking off small packets, and the Ace of Spades ended up on top. The judges hinted at the explanation - it was not a fooler.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00pm.

#### **Arcanum!**

Arcanum is Ring76's private website. To access it, you must be a member in good standing of Ring 76.

At this juncture, the website contains:

- The Ring 76 membership list
- Ring 76 related documents -- our Constitution and Bylaws, for instance
- The Ring 76 Library catalog -- all of the books and DVDs that you can check out plus a collection of magic PDF files that you can download (there's a lot of good material here...)

So hopefully, by now, you are asking yourself, "How do I get access to this?" (This will only work if you are a member of Ring 76.)

- 1. Go to https://arcanum.ring76.com
- 2. Click on "Forgot your username?"

#### Magic Video Streaming Project:


The Magic Video Streaming project is one where we will have all the magic videos we legally own available to members for streaming via a PLEX media server.

#### ORIGINAL CARD THRU WINDOW

Learn how to throw objects through closed windows without breaking either... Join world champion magician Peter Marvey on the streets and on TV to study every aspect of this mind blowing miracle. Objects visibly jump through any window or simply appear outside, tightly taped to the alass.

#### **Docc Hilford's RAVEN'S SLATES**

THE BLURB

Almost every magician of any standing has demonstrated his ability to receive spirit messages. These astral communications nearly always appear silently and in secret.

Not Anymore!

Now, the audience can actually HEAR the chalk write the complete message, and they can SEE the writing slowly come into focus.



Effect:

Two pieces of black slate board are freely shown blank on both sides. Each side is wiped clean with a wet cloth. The slates are set on edge and leaned against a glass. A single piece of chalk is placed between the two boards When the mage extends his finger toward the slates and makes the slightest contact, THE CHALK BEGINS TO WRITE! The audience hears each letter being formed between the slates. They hear the looping of the letters, the crossing of "T"s and the dotting of "T"s. The mage doesn't move at all during the process; not even his finger! The sound of the writing comes from the slates and the actual chalk between them. The outside slate is removed and written in chalk on the second slate is a lengthy message.

There's more! The mage cleans the first state board again, showing both sides shiny black and free of any writing. He leans the single board against another glass. Slowly and silently another message appears before the eyes of the audience! It looks like a ghostly special effect from a movie. Without exaggeration, men have wept witnessing these demonstrations in actual seances.

In a special living and dead test, you can allow a spectator to write the names of several people on one slate, wash them clean, and the only dead name will reoppear on the slate five times larger than originally written! You can cause any messages to appear and the slates can be used over and over. This is a hand-made apparatus that requires over 200 man-hours to produce.



The Ring, the Watch, and the Wallet —Tommy relates how he was recently robbed.

He takes off his ring, takes the money from his wallet, and takes the watch off his wrist. He then very cleanly puts the items in an envelope and openly tears the envelope to shreds. Tommy instantly holds up his hand and there is the ring

back on his finger and the watch on his wrist. He opens up his wallet and there is the money back inside. Truly stunning.

Magic Ranch —Tommy Wonder's take on a Don Alan classic. A plastic egg suddenly appears on the table in front of the spectator and well away from Tommy. A card is selected and lost in the deck of cards. The plastic egg is opened to reveal a miniature duplicate of the selected card. The audience is further stunned when the deck is shown to contain all duplicates of a different card from that which was selected.

Through the Eye of The Needle —A needle and length of thread are shown. The thread is rolled into a big clump and placed on top of the needle. The thread is then miraculously pulled through the eye of the needle again and again until the entire clump is neatly threaded and snipped off at the top. You' re left with a needle tightly threaded with 20 separate strands and an audience in disbelief!

The Tamed Card —Tommy Wonder's unbelievable take on the Peter Kane/Frank Garcia Wild Card plot. Tommy has added a fantastic presentation, turning this into an entertaining piece of theater. It requires no table, it resets easily, has magnificent card changes, is extremely practical, and is designed to fool even those who see it over and over again.

**Two Cup Routine** —Tommy Wonder's claim to fame, the Cups and Balls routine, has fooled some of the best minds in magic. It's practical, does not require loading from the pocket, and will amaze your audiences over and over.

**Elizabeth IV** —The performer removes a clear envelope with a wager and a prediction. Any card is named

and contents of the clear envelope are openly removed. The prediction matches

the freely named card.

**Rubik's Card** —Tommy shows a small box filled with blocks that have card pips on some of their sides. A card is selected and the lid is removed from the box to show that the blocks have somehow arranged themselves to form an image of the selected card.

**Deja Reverse** —Two cards are selected and the first selection magically turns face up. It is turned face down and a magical gesture is made again with the intention of the second selection turning face up. However, when the cards are spread, it is the first selection once again. The first card almost takes on a life of its own, repeating its antics, and in a final act of desperation, Tommy rips up the first selection and tosses it aside. The deck is spread and there, restored face up in the center, is the first card once again. The torn pieces are turned over to reveal the second selection.

**Socked Coins** —This routine has never been explained and has been a closely guarded secret that Tommy Wonder has kept for himself. It's one of the finest coin routines ever created. In a lesson on how to lose money, coins penetrate a spectator's hand in an increasingly impossible manner. It resets, can be done without a table, and is incredibly strong.

Tommy goes on to explain his workings on Cough DROP, vanishing bird cage, the boomerang card, the Zombie Ball, and his wonderful ring and rope routine.

**Nest of Boxes** —Tommy discusses in tremendous detail three unbelievable versions of the Borrowed

Watch to Nest of Boxes. You will shake your head in disbelief and be absolutely dumbfounded.

**Coins Across** —A combination of the

Coins Across plot, a coin box routine, and a wonderful Coin in Eye routine to close. This gets the same strong reaction of the Card On Forehead but with coins. Practical and incredibly strong.

Ambitious Card Plus Ring Box —See why a card trick gets standing ovations time after time. Tommy slowly builds and builds the impossibility of the classic Ambitious Card effect and ends with one of the best versions of the signed card to box plot in existence.

Tommy also demonstrates his fabulous handlings for two classic effects—Card Through Handkerchief and Everywhere and Nowhere.




