### Ring76 Meeting

Monday July 14, 2020 In Cyberspace

This was our installation banquet, and fourth ring meeting held on Zoom. Members, and our performing guest - the amazing **Garrett Thomas** - joined early to chat and discuss.

President **Richard Ustick** called the meeting to order at 7:08pm. There were 23 people online. Richard thanked the outgoing Board, requested any suggestions regarding the meetings online, and then turned the meeting over to IBM Territorial VP **Jeff Marcus** to do the honors with installing

the new Board. Jeff gave a nice, motivational presentation. Richard discussed the challenges for the future of the Ring, with continuing social distancing restrictions, and asked for suggestions from the members for how to keep the Ring interesting and relevant. Treasurer Joe Mystic discussed a free Zoom magic show that his friend **Alex Ramon** is doing - check your email. Incoming secretary Matt **King** announced that he has a studio now in Liberty Station, and he will be doing virtual shows from there, and it could eventually be a 20 seat theater stay tuned. VP for entertainment Greg Wauson announced the winners of the close-up contest: 3rd place was Miguel Garcia, and tied for first place was Mago Ruly and Josh Sherwin. The entertainer-ofthe-year award went to **Matthew King.** The tip-ofthe-hat award went to **Ken Intriligator**, for setting up the Zoom meetings since the start of the lockdown. The member-of-the-year award went to Greg Wauson.

Greg Wauson introduced world-renowned magician and inventor Garrett Thomas, who gave an amazing show. He started with a performance of making a coin jump from one hand to another, introduced an Everlasting Gobstopper, and then showed a creative ambigram which reflected his first name when right side up, and his last name when upside down. Next, he demonstrated solving the Rubik's Cube with just one swipe of the hand, then solving it again in "0 seconds". Garrett Thomas then pulled a Magic 8 Ball from his wallet, and performed a very visual routine where a finger ring penetrated each finger, one at a time, only to end with explaining it's done by "pulling his fingers off", while demonstrating such.

Next, Garrett performed slights with a coin and his finger, stabbing his finger through the coin, then turned the coin into a ring, then back into a coin, then stuck his finger through again, all in a smooth succession. Mark Booth was chosen as a volunteer where his card was shuffled in the deck, and it was said to be in the 27th position, which it wasn't and the incorrect card turned into Mark's card. Then the card was returned to the deck, and the selected card jumped to his pocket multiple times, then showed multiple of the same card and the whole deck. Next, Richard Ustick chose a card, Garrett shuffled it back in the deck, then went through the cards while listening to **Richard's** breathing. He then made all of the black cards vanish, then more cards visibly vanished from the deck until only one card remained, and it was the selected card! Garrett's next effect involved **Greg Wauson** selecting 4 cards, while a fifth card had been previously torn into 4 pieces. Then he ripped off the 4 corners of the selected cards, which ended up matching the with the previously ripped pieces. Following with a coin manipulation routine which involved increasingly giant coins produced from a small coin purse, Garrett also made an 8 Ball grow in size while tossing it in the air. He ended with showing an example of the illusion of depth perception with the camera and different black tables at different depths by bringing objects closer to the camera, and then vanished the Rubik's cube. Afterwards, he touched on the history and philosophy of magic, the art of magic, and hidden metaphors in magic.
