It was the classic of magic with a bit more interaction, where his daughter Summer made her ring penetrate through **David's** ring. **David** had asked for feedback, and **Richard Ustick** made an idea to make it more dramatic or have a little more buildup. **Matthew King** recommended always trying to complete a unique move, because the audience doesn't know what to expect and won't know if you missed.

The 10th Performer was **Matthew King.** Her performed a routine using small movie posters and numbered papers with photos of celebrities printed on them. **Joe "Mystic" McGrievy** selected a

Also present were Librarian and Member-at-Large Gary Salisbury, IBM Regional Representative Jeff Marcus, and Social Media rep. Mark Booth. Sergeant-at-arms David Chiu was not able to attend.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the August meeting were revised and approved.





REPORTS

<u>President Richard Ustick</u> congratulated Matthew King for winning performer of the month for August.

<u>First VP of Entertainment Greg Wauson:</u> The August meeting was a success and we had 10 performers at the August Meeting. **Greg** delivered the plaques to the members.

<u>Second VP (Membership) James Thayer:</u> <u>Membership, Newsletter, and website:</u>

James Thayer indicated we have 62 members and will be going down to 57 at the end of September when un-renewed memberships expire.

Treasurer, Joe "Mystic" McGrievy's, report: Joe showed his excel spreadsheet regarding expenses and status. He indicated he forwarded Gary Salisbury the \$50 donation from Mike Stilwell for the library, he forwarded \$60.85 to Greg Wauson for awards and plaques, and all other checks have cleared. The Ring 76 current balance is \$1,488.56.

Secretary Report – Matthew King – Minutes from August 10, 2020 Zoom Meeting revised and approved.

Sergeant at Arms Report – Dave Chiu Absent

Library Report and Discussion - Gary **Salisbury** – **Gary** shared his screed screen which reflected the various donations we have received. Tom Interval is donating magic books. Fred **Goldberg** has donated books props, etc, but have not organized the handoff yet. Robert Vinson indicated he would photograph things and send them over to Gary. Gary indicated Dan Thomas had donated some books and videos and Robert and Greg had picked them up, and he wanted to check the status. **Robert** indicated it was just a few books but nothing really magic related. Gary indicated that Paul sent an email and said he had things to donate. Robert said he would give a call and see if they are coming in to Ring 76 or going to the ring in Long Beach. Loan Status: 13 items currently on loan. Gary indicated he sent Greg an

email to test the Plex server. Regarding the finances, nothing has changed, and the Library fund remains negative -\$8.58. **Josh Sherwin** has been converting the VHS to DVD format and **Josh** is leaving. He is giving things to **Jeff Pearson**, and he told him to go buy a drive at Costco and **Gary** will reimburse him. **James Thayer** mentioned that the catalog of items in Arcanum is out of date, and **Gary** said he would look into it.

OLD BUSINESS

James Thayer mentioned our web hosting and has not had much luck getting it at a lower price. Joe "Mystic" McGrievy mentioned adding it on his GoDaddy account at no charge. James mentioned needing to make sure the PHP transfer would work, and it sounds like it might, and that it would be ideal for multiple people to have access in case something happens to one of the members.

James recommended filing the necessary paperwork to add the new Secretary, Matthew King to our Statement of Information. Also, James mentioned we need to file the 990-N e-postcard with the IRS and 199N e-postcard with the Franchise Tax Board. Richard Ustick said he will try to do it online.

Gary Salisbury brought up a previous conversation regarding this project and that each member's requirements needs to be documented with a process books which has all necessary information and passwords, and it should be figured out to safeguard club information.





Greg Wauson discussed giving away gift cards for the trivia and for finding something in the newsletter. Gary brought up the Zoom background contest. It was agreed that having something hidden again in the newsletter, and the Zoom background would be fun. Richard mentioned a scavenger hunt with magic items. **Richard** likes the ideas to get more people interested in attending, and Greg mentioned announcing it in the newsletter. Joe mentioned giving the performer of the month a \$25 gift card per monthly performance. Robert mentioned receiving a credit for Ring 76, and Matthew King agreed and said would be great to use the credit at the swap meet. **Greg** mentioned giving a \$10 Starbucks card. **Mark Booth** mentioned a \$10 amazon card, Gary and Richard mentioned \$20 for performer of the month. Greg asked if it is a live stream, and Gary indicated he believes it is pre-recorded. Greg mentioned Joshua Jay does do Zoom appearances. Gary said we would get 3 lessons for \$50, and might be worth it to just ask. **Jeff Marcus** mentioned there are plenty of free lessons around. **Greg** asked if they ask for donations after their lecture, **Jeff** mentioned they will sometimes sell lecture notes and sometime other online specials. **Mark Booth** strongly recommended **Kozmo**, which is free to groups or clubs. **Mark** indicated he does have products for sale, and they are not pushy at all. He does it on Zoom and **Mark** said it was very entertaining. **Greg** said he will follow up on **Kozmo**.

Richard Ustick announced October will be Halloween or Spooky magic. Unfortunately, Bob Meigs does not do Zoom. Greg would like to make it a performance night, with a lecture in November. Richard said December is usually the potluck, so we need to think out it.

Robert Vinson asked for the Club to send a letter to Josh Sherwin to thank him for all of his work with the club and helping out. He leaves September 1st. Jeff Marcus asked for Jeff Goldberg and Dan Thomas to also get some sort of thank you email or letter. Joe "Mystic" McGrievy mentioned having someone design a Certificate of Appreciation. Gary Salisbury mentioned he will do it. Joe mentioned it should also say Ring 76, Robert said it should have the logo. Greg mentioned one of the members did not want the plaque, as he was getting rid of things and downsizing. Gary showed he has certificate letterhead with a shiny border to use.

WHAT'S NEW?

Magic Video Streaming Project:



The Magic Video Streaming project is one where we will have all the magic videos we legally own available to members for streaming via a PLEX media server. At last count, we had over 1,200 instructional and performance magic videos that will be available for viewing on the server.

Current Project Status:

We do have PLEX up and running on the prototype server that is capable of a couple of concurrent video streams. If you would like to try it out, send me an email (gdis46@gmail.com) with your email address requesting access. I will send you a PLEX invitation, which you will need to accept, in order to gain access. Since this prototype server has limited bandwidth we may have to limit the users during this test phase so first come, first served. One requirement: I need you to tell if you see or experience any problems. That way we can solve them before the real server goes into online.

Josh Sherwin has been converting our VHS tapes to MP4 files but the project was interrupted because Josh is moving to South Carolina. He has handed off all the VHS tapes to Jeff Pearson in the interim. I will have to get them from Jeff and finish it up myself.

DONATIONS WANTED

We need more books and videos to build the library. Those have to come from donations because there are no funds earmarked for library acquisitions this year.



We have not raised any additional funding for the library because physical meetings have been cancelled and we have gone to virtual meetings. That means no library sales table or 50/50 raffle.

Currently we need money to buy Windows 10 Pro software and some incidentals for the Magic Video Streaming Server project. If you could help out by donating something for this? We need \$300 more but anything at all will help.

If you have purchased a downloaded video lecture (such as Penguin lectures) and no longer need it, I have a suggestion. Donate it to the library and we will put it on our PLEX server. That way you will always be able to view it any time along with the rest of the club. The club would then officially own the copy however, once it is transferred over to the library, you must delete all copies of it from your system. This is no different than donating a VHS or DVD except the media isn't physical, it is digital.

There is a limit of 4 items per month. You will need to sign the library card attached to the item along with your phone number. We ask that you return the items to the library on or before the monthly meeting for the following month (for example: If you check out a book at the July meeting, it should be returned on or before the August meeting). If need be, you can keep the book or video again if nobody else has requested it but you must sign for it again.

Remember, our objective is to build the best magic reference library in the entire IBM organization world-wide but we need your help to do that. Please return over-due books & videos and donate regularly to your library.
