Coming Up!

August: It will be so good to meet in person – and at our new venue in Old Town! The theme of our August meeting will be mentalism. Wikipedia tells us: "Mentalism is a performing art in which its practitioners, known as mentalists, appear to demonstrate highly developed mental or intuitive abilities." So dust off your whiteboards, blindfolds and Mental Epics and get ready to astonish your fellow Ring 76ers. And if you don't know what a Mental Epic is, come and ask one of your fellow members; we're happy to help you.

We have several performers already lined up to dazzle us at our August 9th meeting with their

mental powers, including our prez, Magic Mike Stilwell, who will wow us with a domino effect and then teach us how to do it. It's not too late for you to join the list of presenters. If you would like to perform a mentalism effect, or maybe a trick you've been wanting to do in front of an audience but it's something other than mentalism, that's ok too. This is your club and we're here for each other; the important thing is that you'll get some stage time in front of a live audience and we'll get to know you a little better. This will be a performance night, so members will vote for their favorites and those votes will count toward the performer of the month as well as the performer of the year.



This is where we talk about your library and do book & video reviews. Yes, your library! If you are a Ring 76 member in good standing, then this is your library! So keep in good standing by paying your dues on time.


OBJECTIVES OF THE LIBRARY

The library's primary objective is to support the art of magic by providing the best reference library in the entire IBM organization for members to learn from. It is here for you so please use it!

We will make it the best by:

- Increasing quantity and quality of materials available to members through donations and acquisitions.
- Implementing easier methods to check materials out.
- Improving communications to members about library issues.
- Implementing record-keeping and other methods to minimize loss.
- Developing a standardized set of policies & procedures on how the library will operate.





WHAT'S NEW AT THE LIBRARY?

IBM Ring 76 Magic Media Server:

The <u>IBM Ring 76 Magic Media Server</u> project is one where we will have all the magic videos we legally own available to members for streaming via a PLEX media server. At last count, we had over 1,200 instructional and performance magic videos that will be available for viewing on the server. That is about 4TB online. The Magic Castle has a similar service for their members but theirs is 28TB online. Keep donating and we will beat them!

Current Project Status:

The <u>IBM Ring 76 Magic Media Server</u> is up and running so if you would like to try it out, send an email to:(librarian@ring76.com) with your real email address (not your ring email address) requesting access. I will send you a PLEX invitation, which you will need to accept, in order to gain access. People who have tried it say it is nothing less than **FANTASTIC!**

IBM Ring 76 Library:

The Ring 76 Library is physically located at my home in Blossom Valley and anyone is welcome to stop by and browse as much as you desire.


It is stored on a heavy duty Sterling shelving system in my 3 car garage.



IBM RING 76 MAGICAL ARTS LIBRARY

Currently we have 16 feet of wall space but as donations grow, the available space becomes smaller. We need more room so I came up with an idea.

My garage is 2 cars wide and 2 deep on one side. I decided to convert the 3rd bay (shown in red) into a dedicated room for the library.

Construction is underway but going slow because I am doing this all myself and the recent heat levels makes it had to work in the afternoons.

I have cleared out about half of the existing cabinetry and reinstalled it. The next task will to be to add the wall and new door and then we have to patch and paint the room. After



that the new cabinetry gets installed and the library unpacked. We then have to do a complete inventory and get it published so you know what books and videos we have. Volunteers are always welcome to assist. Perhaps we

should have a party for the unveiling of the new library? What do you think?

Soliciting Library Donations:

Over the past months I have been soliciting donations of books and videos from different magic groups on Facebook and have received a lot of material; books, video, and props. All the props went to the IBM Ring 76 Magic Store to raise funds for the general fund. All the videos will be digitized and made available for streaming from out PLEX IBM Ring 76 Magic Media Server. All the books will be put into our library. Any duplicates will be sold to members at ring meetings.

If you have any magic DVDs or VHS tapes, why not consider donating them to the library? They will be digitized and put on the PLEX server so they would always be available to you any time plus be sharable to other club members. Sharing is good!

JULY 2021 DONATIONS

Thanks to the generosity of a few, we have a few more items that we can all share and funds to build with. Thanks again for your generosity and setting an example for others to (hopefully) follow.

Ken Intriligator donated the \$10 gift card he won through the newsletter contest. Thank you again, Ken!

Dr. Kato Whiting donated a \$100 check and a box of props to the library. Look for more on this at the next meeting.

Gary Salisbury reapplied a previous \$300 donation, that was used for library shelving, back into the petty cash fund. I will absorb the \$1,000 cost of shelving for the library myself. The library petty cash fund is now at \$420, enough to buy the software we need for the PLEX server and other library essential items.

DONATIONS WANTED

We need more books and videos to build the library. Those have to come from donations because there are no funds earmarked for library



acquisitions in the ring budget. I



would like to raise about \$500 for new book and video purchases for the library at the upcoming Magic Live! convention next spring.

<u>Think about this:</u> If you have purchased a downloaded video lecture (such as Penguin lectures) and no longer need it, I have a suggestion. Donate it to the library and we will put it on our PLEX server. That way you will always be able to view it any time along with the rest of the club. The club would then officially own the copy however, once it is transferred



over to the library, you must delete all copies to do that. of it from your system. This is no different than donating a VHS or DVD except the media isn't physical, it is digital.

LOAN STATUS

Six items still currently on loan. If you have something checked out, it would be appreciated if you could drop it off or make arrangements to have it picked up.

LIBRARY CHECK OUT PROCEDURE

Members may contact me 7x24 either by email at <u>librarian@ring76.com</u> or by cell phone (voice or text) at 619-569-6035 to let me know what you would like to check out. (If you do not hear back from me within 24 hours, there may have been a technical problem so call me.) I will make sure the item(s) get to the next monthly meeting or you can pick it up at my home in Blossom Valley.

There is a limit of 4 items per month. You will need to sign the library card attached to the item along with your phone number. We ask that you return the items to the library on or before the monthly meeting for the following month (for example: If you check out a book at the July meeting, it should be returned on or before the August meeting). If need be, you can keep the book or video again if nobody else has requested it but you must sign for it again.

Remember, our objective is to build the best magic reference library in the entire IBM organization world-wide_but we need your help

to do that. Please return over-due books & videos and donate regularly to your library.

Non-urgent communications will always be done via the <u>Ex Libris newsletter article</u> while more urgent communications will be done by an <u>IBM</u> <u>Ring 76 LibraryGram</u> emailed to ring76members@googlegroups.com.
