





FROM THE NORTH:

Use I-5 south thru the Oceanside area and watch for "Carlsbad Next 7 Exits" sign. A few exits past the sign use "Carlsbad Blvd./Palomar Airport Road" .Exit - east. (right exit from I-5 then left at top of exit ramp at stop sign.

Go about 2 blocks then left at the light onto "Paseo del Norte". Go ½ block and left into complex entrance. Park in front of or beside the Windmill. Terrace Room is on street level in the back.

FROM THE SOUTH:

Use I-5 north to Carlsbad. Take "Carlsbad Blvd./Palomar Airport Road" exit - east. (about 17 miles north of the I-5 and I-805 junction) Right at top of exit ramp then left at the light onto "Paseo del Norte". Go $\frac{1}{2}$ block then left into complex entrance. Pain front of or beside the Windmill.

Terrace Room is on street level in the back
