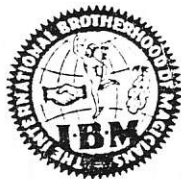
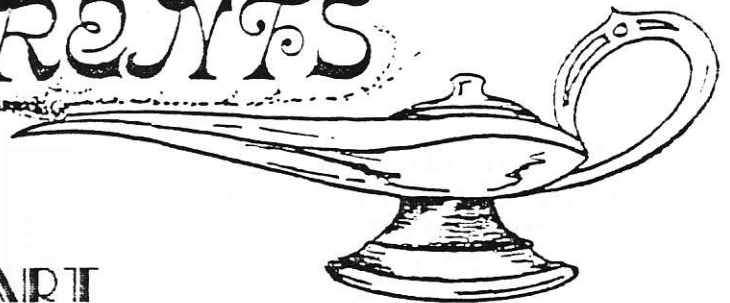

ELECTION TIME

And time to start thinking about whom you want to run the Ring for the next YEAR! In accordance with the By-Laws, no person can be elected to the same office for three consecutive years. This will mean some big changes for the coming year. **Dick DALE** and **J.P. JACKSON** will both step down leaving their positions open, so we will need a new president and a new secretary for the membership year 1990-1991. In accordance with the same By-Laws, the President will soon be appointing a Nominating Committee of not less than three members. The Board of Directors will provide the Nominating Committee with a recommended slate of officers, and the Committee's slate will be presented to the Membership at the May Meeting. Formal elections will be held in June.

As outgoing president, **Dick DALE** will become a member of the Board of Directors. We will also be electing one other new member of the Board at the June meeting. Please remember that the slate proposed by the Board and presented by the Nominating Committee is, by no means, the final say. It is really just

the start of the election process and intended to identify some prospective candidates to RUN AGAINST. What we really need, (this year more than ever) is lots of nominations from the floor. It would be a real plus to have at least two candidates for each office so we could have a REAL ELECTION in June. All you prospective candidates out there should start thinking about WHICH specific office you want to run for, and make yourself known to the Nominating Committee.

The Business Meeting started the solicitation of volunteers for our forthcoming Public Show (date to be determined); approved a proposal from our "junior affiliate", *THE SAN DIEGO JUNIOR MAGICIANS*, to provide refreshments at our monthly meetings, and announced that dues will remain at twelve dollars for the forthcoming Membership Year.

President **Dick DALE** started the magic with his choice from his first year in magic, *SPOOKY SPOTS*, the 2" x 3" plaques, hinged at the base with the cute rabbit decals on the back and the jumping/color changing spot. It's still available in plastic from Germany and Japan, I think; but **Dick** had an original wooden one, complete with the old rusty disc gimmick. **Brad BURT** showed us his umpteen year old "back and front" palm from his first year in magic, and guest, **Jessie JUDGE**, performed the *KNOT IN YOUR SHOELACE* rope routine with vanishing knots.

Dave CALIGARTI NELSON did a nice coin routine from his past with coin productions from the air, some very nice work with the *T. NELSON DOWN'S CLIP PALM* and an interlocked fingers coin production. He finished with a great Coin-Thru-Silk effect, leaving the coin very cleanly on the palm of his hand as the silk was withdrawn. **Cal MAYERS** did the *BALL AND VASE* from his old *MYSTO MAGIC* set, and then a very nice prediction effect using a copy of *LINKING RING* and several corner pieces of newspaper containing the page numbers. They were selected at random, added to find a page number in the *LINKING RING*, and the magazine opened only to find the page missing, and found in a double sealed envelope.

Joe FLORIAN did *TENKAI's REVERSE CARD* effect, which he learned during his first year in *TARBELL VOL. I*, a nice *TRIUMPH* routine, and finished with the penetration of a chosen card through a handkerchief which had been wrapped around the entire deck. **SUNNY THE CLOWN** did a great version

of an old classic from her first year. She had a toothpick chosen from a whole box and marked with a crayon. It was wrapped in a hank, broken into pieces, and restored, complete with crayon marking. A really nice routine that just proves again, the older the better!

BOARD MEETING

TOM OGDEN, internationally known comedian and magician, brings to the stage 14 years of performing experience. His early professional touring was with Circus Kirk, then later with the famous Clyde Beatty-Cole Bros. Circus, with which he appeared in over half of the United States. This led into three seasons of shows in schools and universities across the country where Tom performed live in over 1,500 schools before an estimated one million students.

In addition, TOM OGDEN is now a regular performer at such clubs as the Magic Castle, Magic Island, the Laff Stop, the Ice House and The Comedy and Magic Club. Returning to outdoor amusements, OGDEN has been seen at Knott's Berry Farm, Disneyland and the Queen Mary.
