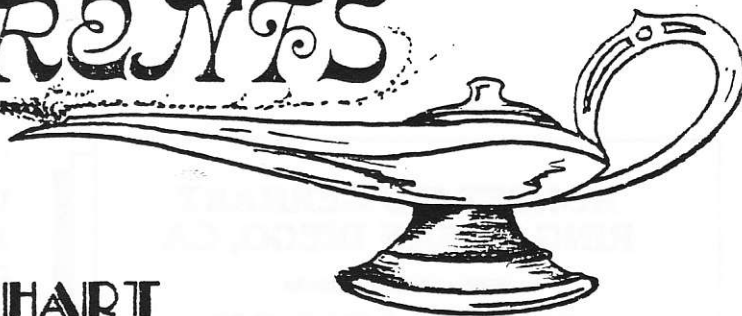

Avid accumulator, J.P.Jackson, provided a brief Collector's (Silk) Corner as the pre-meeting event with a display of Rice Silks and a brief history of Silk King Studios - a unique magic institution for sixty years and never again to be duplicated. JP provided copies of the **Harold RICE** article, "*Take Care of your Silks*"; from the February '67 *LINKING RING*.

The Business Meeting announced the **Mike Caveney** Lecture at **BRAD BURT'S MAGIC SHOP** on Saturday, July Twenty Eighth, the **MAGICIAN'S GUILD OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA FUTAGAWA** lecture on August Third, and a possible lecture by **DARYL** on August Seventh (very busy magical two weeks). More great prizes from **BUMPER AND COMPANY** for the monthly drawing, and tasty refreshments by the "juniors" at the break.

**Jack EVANS** led off the "Classroom Magic" program with a nifty, small-model-house, Card Castle, a wand-to-fan transformation, and a jumbo wand to circular fan which had the chosen card imprinted. **Frank HERMAN** took a new novelty prop (the mirror box/coin bank) and turned it into a superior fifteen minute routine with "Coke Machine" patter, coin vanishes and reproductions, and a streamer production from the bank at the end. Talk about INNOVATIVE! This man never quits.

Past President and teacher, **Jim RILEY**, conducted a quick TOPOLOGY lecture from his actual classroom "teacher aids" file, and changed two metal circles into a square and a triangle to illustrate his Geometry lesson. **Ed RAYMOND** showed us a re-do of **Cal MAYER'S** Vanishing-Knot-in-a-Cardboard-Tube from last month's meeting - and fooled himself! Veteran **James SWOGER** demonstrated a novel, and flashy, tossed-knot-onto-rope flourish and with the help of four extra hands holding various loops and ends, tried to show it in slow motion! It was fantastic in real time. Wish we'd had a video for the slow motion part.

Professor **Rich ROBERTSON** gave us a quick math lesson with the "pick a number and double it" routine and a large poster board MAGIC SQUARE which he uses in the Classroom for Math reinforcement. **Henry VACA** teaches Vocabulary and Pronunciation Skills on the School Playground with a jumbo "TREE OF HEARTS" card effect and a very clever routine with a Card Duck doing math - good practical ideas. **Bob INGALLS** showed us some quick card addition ideas to get the educational stuff out of the way, then did a funny Lassoed Card effect as his real work. **Jack MARKLEY** decided that we were all due for a shot of Gospel Magic, which more than qualified for the Theme, and did a very strong A B C Block routine with excellent Gospel patter. **Dave LAMBERT** closed the program with his confused "Spot Card" routine, which he also uses in the Class Room, and gave a very nice lecture on optical illusions and perception complete with a neat Side Show - a nice finish.

A real treat to have **Mike CAVENY** for our Annual Installation Banquet on July Twenty Seventh. A very special night! Forty Five Members and Guests enjoyed a very nice social hour and a bountiful Chicken Dinner. TVP **Joe BERTUZZI** installed the new Ring

Officers, presented plaques to the out-going Officers, and the Member-Of-The-Year award to Second Vice President **Bob INGALLS** for his never-ending support to the Ring. **Mike CAVENY** took over for a very full evening of his special brand of Magicomedy. We need more help on the third Monday of each month making cookies, cakes and brownies to sell so we can make money. Please bring something to sell.

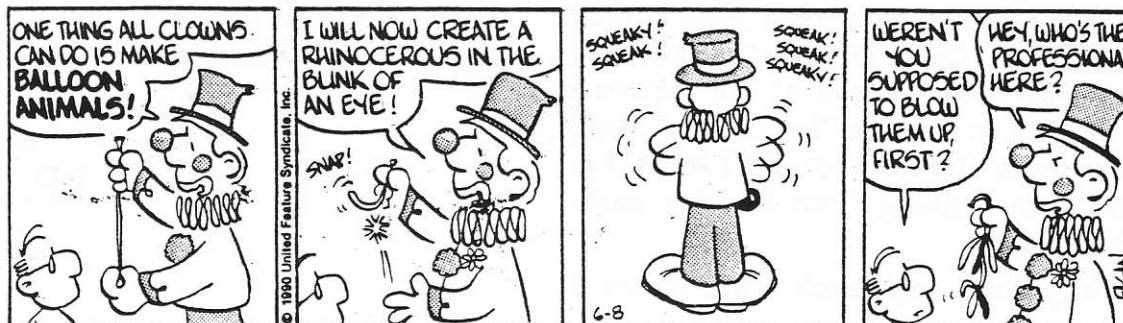
After the business meeting **Don HALBACH** demonstrated "*JUDGE LYNCH'S NECKTIE PARTY.*"
