The treasury was reported "sound", the Secretary's Minutes were reported in the last MAGICURRENTS, and we raced through a quick raffle, which included a full set of BUMPER'S Linking Rings, to get to the main event: Hank MOOREHOUSE. "COMEDY ON STAGE" was the title; and, indeed, it was. Lots of good, working, fun stuff with all standard props.

He started with a nice tip on "getting introduced" for any performance, and went into some very enlightening material with Sponge Balls which included the best audience participation for this old standard that I've ever seen. Again it's not "what" but "how". He did a clever routine with a one hundred dollar bill, signed, burned, and relocated in a Lippencot Box, but the bits, asides, and byplay made it unique, and extra fun.

A nice TEN CARD/THREE CARDS ACROSS routine followed, demonstrating some exceptional handling (in plain sight), and then he borrowed a cigarette, got mixed up and lit the lighter with the cig, with lots of other funny bits with lighters and cigs. It was even done with appropriate applications for non-smokers - nice.

He demonstrated his handling and unique patter for the "DO NOTHING (OR BOO BOO) BAR" with every possible "doing nothing" gag ever heard, and followed with a very involved CUT AND RESTORED ROPE item: double ropes, big fat, double knots in an incredible mess until the restoration. It's called the CUATEMALA ROPE TRICK, and is based on the PANAMA ROPE routine from TARBELL - check it out.

He finished with a nice version of the "SIDEWALK SHUFFLE", and we all took a

break. After resetting, Hank went through the entire act a second time with explanations, tips, and details; AND an extra good tip on how to get the audience to applaud and when. He added several neat items from Europe including a chosen card from one half of a deck, an amazing "force" with a \$100 dollar bill tied to the last piece of "knitted" rope chosen, and finished it all with sponge Multiplying Cats which permitted the enhancement of this old classic with SOUND EFFECTS. Great Idea!

SLEIGHTLY NEWS ROUND TOWN




