WHERE DID EVERYONE GO?




CROSS TALK





SELLERS set up for Auction Pre-View from 7 to 7:30 PM. Regular Business Meeting at 7:30, followed by a Break and the Raffle - AUCTION WILL START AT 8:00 PM.

RULES FOR SELLERS: PLEASE, Prime items only - (the junk went at the Oct Swap Meet)

- 1. Make three lists of items to be sold; copy for Recorder, the Auctioneer and your-self. List minimum bids or "No Min". Organize your stuff in accordance with your List; YOU Decide which items go first. Auctioneer's copy stays with your stuff!
- 2. Items must be complete and include instructions OR INDICATE WHAT'S WISSING.
- 3. Package items individually (Zip-Loc Bags), indicate condition: New, Fair, Ex. etc.
- 4. Magazines and Pamphlets should be packaged in bundles. Hardbound books separately.
- 5. New Delers items will not be auctioned; can be sold directly after the Auction.
- 6. Sellers will be paid at the end of the evening, LESS 10% RING FEE.
- 7. NO PRE-AUCTION SALES; once in the Room, it goes on the "block" !!

RULES FOR BUYERS:

- 1. Register at the door with the SGT-AT-ARMS and pick up a numbered BIDDER Card.
- 2. Sales will be CASH only; bring small Bills and Change.
- 3. Items will be delivered as sold. PAY FOR WINNING BIDS AT EACH BREAK.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Only 4 or 5 items per seller will be offered at a time until each seller's items have been offered once. A break will occurr after all sellers have been seen, during which, Buyers will pay for merchandise received up to that point.
- 2. The second rotation will start with first seller again and continue, with breaks, until all sellers' items have been exhausted.
