Thanks to some of the members who have been performing: Dana LAW for the Children's Dental Health Week, Tom CLAYTOR for the U.S.O., and Loch David CRANE for his "TRICKS FOR THE TROOPS" with Jack WHITE and Dana LAW.

Now on to the Lecture: Warren was great. He has over seventy five items on the market. Warren has original material which is easy to do & colorful that entertained everyone. He interjected humor everywhere in the lecture. The Ring was thoroughly entertained for hours. Warren incorporated a variety of magic: Close-up, Mentalism, Off-beat Comedy, etc. "SUPER SILK TRANSPORT" was a clever trick using two silver colored tubes & two different colored, ungimmicked silks. The silks change places. "CLEAR THROUGH" was a wonderful penetration effect using a Jumbo Card secured in a plastic holder with a nut and bolt. The nut is removed and the card slides out of the holder even though the bolt remains in place. Sherry LUFT helped Warren with the effect and was amazed. He performed "WILTING FLOWERS" with the help of Bernie KLEINKE, and also with James SWOGER. One of Warren's favorite props was the "wobble" wand. Next was "WACKY SILKS" - great entertainment. There were three plastic tumblers on a tray with silks. The silks change colors. Then "OH, WEEGEF" with the help of Sherry LUFT. It's a great haunted pack. The pack cuts itself under the spectator's fingers. revealing the chosen card. "CLIPPITY CLIP" with the help of Monica LACE and Logan HALE was a great Close-Up effect. The color of the clip matches the color of the chosen

card. Next was a mental effect with the help of Ken DEWOODY using flash cards and spectator matched the prediction previously placed in the envelope. Then on to the nest of wands with Bryce HAMMOND. They were beautiful brass wands. It was fun. MENTAL COERCION" was next with ESP Cards with the help of John CADDY, Robert PRIOR. SUNNY the Clown, and Terry & Bruce LOVE. Next "ASTRO LINK" which was great. Brass Rings were dropped into a cup and tossed into the air as a chain. For his "TELETHESIA II" used geometric designs on large cards. Warren revealed the chosen design on a clip board. Very versatile effect. It was all great, workable magic! Dispersed among his magic he talked about his philosophy. One of the favorites, "Don't run when no one is chasing."

### BOARD MEETING

The Board was hosted by Jan EASTMAN on April First WITH Jeff & Peg MARCUS, J.P.JACKSON, Sherry LUFT, Dick and Julie DALE, and Paul BARTON. # 'Diamond Jack' amazes Ramada Express guests with magic act

Disappearing coins, vanishing aces, mystifying card tricks... just another day at a Nevada gambling hall, some wiseacre might say.


But not at the Ramada Express, where these amazing acts of prestidigitation will be presented, not by a blackjack dealer or a slot machine, but by house magician "Diamond Jack" James T, Beamon.

"People see what I do and they say it's practically impossible," said Beamon, who lives in Bulhead City. "But I do it right under their noses."

Beamon, a student of magic for more than 60 years, considers himself a "close-up" artist, practicing sleight of hand effects using coins, playing cards, scarves, dollar bills and other small objects.

From a deck of 52 regular playing cards, Beamon can have a subject "pick a card, any card," as they say, and then, without looking, tell exactly what the card is. He can seemingly move objects through space, from one location to another, put torn cards back together again, or make George Wahington turn a flip-flop on a one-dollar bill.

"The things that I do in my shows are of my own development," said Beamon, who worked in the wholesale produce industry for 27 years.

"I have put my own touches on each effect. Nobody can copy my personality."

A member of the world-famous Magic Castle club in Los Angeles, Beamon has performed in the close-up room there and at numerous venues in Laughlin and Bullhead City. Many of his performances have been for charitable organizations, hospitals and convalescent homes.

"He never says 'no' when someone calls him to perform for children or hospitals," said his wife, Celeste.

"The charitable work is too numerous to keep track of."

"Diamond Jack" will be showing off his talents at the Ramada Express on a variety of occasions, during special events, tournaments and parties and to entertain diners who are waiting to be served.


