With the help of Sunny he performed "WAND THRU STRING". Frank continued on with other penetrations: bracelet, dollar bill, and table knife. Next, James SWOGER an April '55 effect, his own invention, called "ENCHANT-ING COLOR CHANGE". It was a color change using Bill. balls in silk while reading the instructions. It was a beautiful effect! Dana LAW performed a slick ball manipulation from January 1979. Cal MAYERS, with Julie, did his traditional Jumbo Deck. Bob ALLEN did a great mental prediction from Nov. 1988, with Julie HAR-RIS. From three sealed envelopes Bob guessed the correct number, a geometric figure, and a common object. Bob INGALLS did a "take-off" on Frank HERMAN's "whiz whistle". Ed FORSYTHE performed from the Paul MORLEY Parade of Aug 1947. He did a nice cut and restored and multiplication of a bill. Jack EVANS completed the evening with a Dec.'85 effect called "SILK SHAKE". It's a very flashy double silk in a bottle production.
