Roy Armstrong forced the only jumbo card in a standard deck on David Lane. The jumbo was then freely inserted back into the pack, and the card directly above it was shown to be a perfect match to the jumbo. Roy then showed the same basic effect again using a slightly different method.

Next, Eddie Raymond risked his own money for the sake of magic, or did he? With his own \$5.00 bill securely padlocked in a clear container, Eddie let four helpers freely select four of the five keys lying on a tray. When the helpers tried their keys for a shot at the money, only the unselected key opened the lock. Rich Robertson was next and did a masterful job with "Chronologue" by Collector's Workshop. Greg Brouelette then took center stage with three excellent effects. After a quick mental effect accomplished with the help of his "Grandpa John", Greg found two selected cards while blindfolded. He concluded with his floating bill routine, and believe me, if you saw this you would swear that the dollar bill could actually fly!

Rob Wasson was next up and really disrupted our sense of reality with a very visual blank deck routine. The effect, "Reality & Illusion", is a creation of Rob's and he is marketing it for \$20.00. From what I saw, you're getting a lot of magic for your money. Rick Waterhouse was our final performer and, as usual, he was just as funny as he was magical. With Rob Wasson assisting, and pens disappearing, Rick appeared to have trouble

finding a card with the correct name written on it. In the end, the whole deck vanished, leaving a mystified Rob holding only his signed selection.


SURVEY RESULTS REGARDING — MAGICURRENTS


