
As with all our gatherings, please feel free to bring your


Location

November Meeting

Magicians like to be surprised and our October meeting started off with a big one: due to a scheduling conflict with the restaurant where our club meets we were unable to meet there. And we found out just a couple of hours before our scheduled starting time. Our quick-thinking president called several businesses in the area and found an ice cream parlor which accommodated us. He posted a notice with the new location for the night at our usual restaurant and we were in business.

Our pre-meeting consisted of a review of Magic Heritage Day. The overwhelming consensus was that it was a big hit and accomplished its goal of raising the public awareness of *Ring 76* and promoting magic in San Diego. Rick Waterhouse thanked everyone who contributed their time and effort to the event and reviewed the highlights. He mentioned several *Ring 76* members met with a representative of the San Diego Historical Society several days after Magic Heritage Day and were told how pleased the Historical Society was with the event. Their volunteers had a very enjoyable afternoon and were thrilled seeing Villa Montezuma used as a public venue.

Treasurer **Jim Jolly** reported the club made a profit of \$42 from Magic Heritage Day. That's not much but the intent was not to make money but just to break even. Most of the profit came from **Don Soul**'s caricatures and the evening seances. Additional revenue was made from the sale of snacks and drinks. More income would have been generated if we had an outside donation box; it was intended but was simply forgotten.

A hand-raise vote was taken and overwhelmingly we decided to consider presenting a Magic Heritage Day next year.

Greg Wauson mentioned he had called T.C. Tahoe but could not catch him home. He will continue to call.

Joe Mystic told the attendees about the Petrick and Mia magic show and lecture planned for November 22. Its \$6 admission fee for the show and a total of \$12 for the show and post-show lecture was certainly reasonable. It faced stiff competition, though, from being scheduled on the same evening as a two-hour "World's Greatest Magicians" show on TV.

Rick Waterhouse mentioned his interest in bringing Jay Scott Barry to San Diego for a lecture.

Rick then set up a TV and VCR and played several videos of old-time magic pros. One of the highlights was Cardini's brilliant performance with cards, balls and cigarettes. Also very entertaining was Harry Blackstone Sr.'s dancing handkerchief and buzzsaw illusion. A German illusionist named Kalanag was shown with a barring levitation of a female assistant.

Next were soon clips of several of the entertainers at Magic Heritage Day, thanks to the flowing efforts of **David Lane**. Joe Mystic, Monte Stratton, Kalamar, **Loch World Crane**, Rick Waterhouse and Greg Wauson were shown with their fine patermances.
