

Dick Dale motioned to set policy that, in the future, those having sent money to reserve space at a Ring event will not have their money refunded if they fail to be present at the event. This idea was based on the fact that even though our banquet turn out of 81 exceeded the 73 guests expected, the Ring suffered a loss of approximately \$375 for the evening.

One member's notes on the back of the voting ballot indicated that visitors to a Ring meeting should be introduced by his or her sponsor. In view of the notion that some visitors may attend as a result of fliers at **Brad Burt** or otherwise unsponsored, Dick suggested having designated greeters to provide such function.

The cost of the performance platform was next taken on. The board agreed to reimburse Don for his unauthorized payment for the platform to **Tom Kasner** due to the ill-timed necessity to provide it. On the subject of reimbursement, Julie informed us that **Joe Mystic** would like a retabulation of newsletter expenses he incurred prior to July, 1997 citing a discrepancy between his estimated cost and the valid receipts he submitted.

Regarding Rick Bruce's public show plans, the board decided to hold the show at the Legion Hall with parking left up to those who attend, since the used car lot next to the Hall is not an option. Therefore, Rick should proceed. With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
