
There is a full, no host, bar on the premises so you can purchase whatever you want o drink. The Ring will provide water and coffee.

MINUTES OF RING 76 BOARD MEETING

November 28, 2016

The meeting was called to order by President Joe "Mystic" McGrievy at 7:27 pm (dinner started at 7:00pm). The entire board was present: the First V.P. (Entertainment) Richard Ustick, Second V.P. (Membership) James Thayer, Secretary Ken Intriligator, Treasurer Bob Meigs, Sergeant-at-Arms Sherry Luft, Member-at-Large and Newsletter Editor Malcolm Campbell, and Member-at-Large (Past President and current Librarian) Kenny Shelton, with guest Lupe Shelton.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the October Board meeting was approved.

REPORTS

Treasurer's report Treasurer Bob Meigs presented his report to the board. There were several minimal changes. Income from the swap meet offset most of the expense of the Kozmo lecture. The report was approved by the board.

Library report Kenny Shelton reported that the library is doing well. There was a donation of additional volumes.

Membership report It was noted that Ring 76 now has 63 members in good standing, including 11 Life Members.

November ring meeting report This was one of the most successful swap meets in recent memory, with twelve sellers (several people were there to give things away!).

OLD BUSINESS

<u>Ring incorporation</u> Malcolm is continuing to look into getting the ring incorporated, as a 501c6.

NEW BUSINESS

Holiday Banquet (December 12). We have been assured by the Mission Bay Boat and Ski Club that we will be able to use their facility for the banquet. Donations will be gratefully accepted for raffles. Members will be asked to bring potluck items. Drinks could be purchased from the Boat Club bar; the ring will bring water and decaf coffee. Terry Lunceford will coordinate entertainment. We will plan to arrive between 6-7pm, eat from 7-8pm, and entertainment will start at 8pm.

<u>January Meeting</u> We expect it will be at the Boat and Ski Club, to be confirmed. The theme will be new (to me) magic.

Other Business Cary mentioned to Joe that Scott Alexander might be available to lecture next Spring. Richard will contact him to follow up.

<u>Kozmo Lecture</u> There was some discussion / recap of Kozmo's lecture. There was also discussion about how to advertise future lectures to people outside of the ring, particularly young people.
