San Diego's beloved "Magic Doc" Jeff Pearson passed away from pancreatic cancer on August 4, 2024, after a remarkable lifetime of magic. More than a magician, Jeff was a fantastic human being who brought joy and laughter to every world he inhabited. He was a frequent participant in meetings of IBM Ring 76 with his wife Laurie. He was the inventor of the popular "Chick Magnet" necklaces.

Jeff always had a twinkle in his eye. And a pocketful of tricks. And an irreverent joke to share. He took childhood delight in shocking people. He was a wonderful paradox, with advanced sleight of hand skills and a demented juvenile sense of humor. Members of IBM Ring 76 plan to celebrate the man with a broken wand ceremony on Monday, September 9, during the regular club meeting in Old Town



The public service for Jeff will be on Sunday, September 8, at the Seaside Center for Spiritual Living, 1613 Lake Dr. in Encinitas. The memorial service will be from 4-5 p.m., followed by a reception from 5-6 p.m. Visiting will be open until 7 p.m.

Parking Lot Changes

A Gentle Reminder

Fellow Ring members, due to an increase in the number of priests who are living at the Church, we have been instructed that the ONLY available parking spaces in the little gated parking lot on Church grounds are the five spaces on the SOUTHWEST side of the parking lot.

Two of those spaces (the one near the rec hall door and the one farthest from the door) are reserved for our Librarian and our VP of Entertainment and in consideration of our members with mobility issues, your Board has voted that the remaining spaces be designated Handicap Only, available on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE basis. Any member parking in one of those four spaces must display a Handicap Placard or have Handicap plates on their vehicle.

We understand that, at times, members will need to unload/load their equipment near the door. The spot immediately in front of where our Librarian parks (small BLUE rectangle) is the ONLY unloading/loading spot. You may park there for only as long as it takes to unload/load but please DO NOT leave your vehicle parked there while you set up your equipment.

The important part of this is to NEVER inconvenience the priests who live there. We are VERY lucky to have this meeting spot available to us.


December will be our annual Holiday Pot

Life of Jeff Cont. from pg. 1

Jeffrey Pearson was born May 2, 1957, in the small town of Kirksville, Missouri. His ancestors came from a little town on the outskirts of Rome. He was proud of his Italian heritage. A curious lad, Jeff grew up in New Jersey with his parents Robert and Eleanor, and his younger sisters Lori and Wendy. At an early age, he favored outdoor activities, theater, and music. He went camping, visited National Parks, and could often be found playing his guitar.

More than a renaissance man, Jeff was known in various worlds as a doctor, a magician, a musician, an improv actor, a free speech advocate, a film nerd, and a tech geek, to name a few. But the universe most important to Jeff was always his family.



Jeff's interest in medicine also started young, because his dad was a doctor in family medicine. Jeff went to medical school and got his degree. And more than that. He met his first wife Elaine in the 1980s while going to college. The pair married, and

eventually, Jeff joined his father's practice in medicine. They had two children, Samantha and Michael. When the family moved to San Diego, the couple started their own practice, Medicine in Motion.

Daughter Sam has fond memories of her dad bringing her to hospitals. "He always told me hospitals had a bad reputation—people die there. But his goal was to make it fun. A magic trick or a conversation." She said, adding, "His whole thing was to make a crappy situation a better situation... Always a positive spin."

Over the years, Jeff continued to evolve as a doctor, going above and beyond the call of duty in Family and Sports Medicine. He mentored several generations of young doctors, physician's assistants, and nurse practitioners in the "art" of medicine. In other words, he taught them how to communicate with patients, be a good listener, and make them feel comfortable.

He was my family physician. I can tell you he was excellent in his craft, but also highly entertaining. There were comedy props in the exam rooms. There were sponge balls and coins everywhere, along with decks of cards. He had the funniest jokes to accompany his procedures. I won't even tell you about the time he had me bent over in laughter, during my first prostate exam. Ever the volunteer, Jeff learned how to

speak Spanish, so he could communicate with his Spanish-speaking clients. He frequently volunteered his services to the migrant families in the Tijuana border region. At the same time, he worked with Olympic athletes. He also volunteered at local colleges and served as a team physician at Rancho Bernardo High School.

Magic was one of the strongest suits in Jeff's personality. His powerful skills were no accident; Jeff studied personally with some of the greatest magicians of all time, like Bob Elliott and J.C. Wagner. When Jeff remarried in 2012, his wedding to Laurie was held in the towering Stratosphere Hotel in Las Vegas. One famous magician, Paul Draper, officiated, and another famous magician, Johnny Thompson, produced a dove during the ceremony.

When they first met, Laurie said she was attracted to Jeff's upbeat positive energy, but she wondered if he could survive the vetting process. At that time, Laurie had a habit of taking her dates out on trail runs, to see if they could keep up with her. "Jeff was the only one who could survive three runs with me," she said. "I tried to lose him on the trail, but I turned around and he's right behind me. I couldn't lose him."

When Jeff was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer, he retired from his medical practice after 35 years and began an aggressive fight. There were experimental treatments. He was down for the count more than once, but he kept coming back. All along the way, he documented his experiences on social media. He wrapped up production and recording of 35 original songs.

And Jeff kept living, checking off items on his bucket list of life-affirming activities with Laurie, going to concerts, holding Saturday night Karaoke

parties, and movie nights, and growing with his various communities of friends.

During Jeff's final years, he turned his attention back to family. "All of us saw the humble changes in him," said Sam. "He started to listen. He started to understand. There was real family healing."



Near the end, Laurie said that Jeff never admitted to the pain he was suffering. He even welcomed guests to his home to say goodbye. I was one of those

guests. He requested bad jokes, so I obliged him with my best gallows humor. For example, I told him that even a defective parachute will last you a lifetime.

A few weeks before passing, Jeff fulfilled a final bucket list item. He rallied his strength, and he took his sister Wendy to Disneyland, a place she had never visited before. "Jeff got an ADA pass and an electric scooter. He had the app on his phone," Laurie said. "He was go go go. He was unstoppable!"

Jeff passed away at 6 a.m. on Aug. 4, 2024, with the trifecta of death: he was home, he was with his wife (and a cat by his side), and he had hospice care onsite. More than that, he had the love and appreciation of thousands of people. And the tributes keep pouring in.

Welcome to Ex Libris, my monthly newsletter article about the IBM Ring 76 Library in San Diego, CA.

'Ex Libris' (Eh-cks LEE-breese), means 'From the Book'. Generally, you will see this term used on bookplates to denote that it came from the library of its owner. For example: "Ex Libris: Gary Salisbury."

This is where we talk about your library as well as do book and video reviews. Yes, your library! If you are a Ring 76 member in good standing, then this is your library! So be sure to stay in good standing by paying your dues on time.

Someone recently asked me, "What is the Ring 76 Library?" I responded, "It is currently over 1,000 volumes of magic books and magazines, all available for check-out. It is 602 magic audiobooks, 1,688 magic instruction videos, 86 full length magic movies, 8 albums of magic music (some royalty free), 1,481 magic performance videos (many classics), 10 podcasts (over 2,000 episodes we that co-host), 23 magic TV series, a photo warehouse (where we will save all our Ring 76 activity photos) and all this is available for streaming from the *Ring 76 Magic Media Server*.

It is also a museum for a collection of historic Ring 76 memorabilia from one of our founders, Honest Sid Gerhart. It is a magical learning source unparalleled in the entire IBM organization and it is funded totally from donations and fund-raising efforts that I have engage in for your behalf."

Ring 76 Magic Media Server (Streaming Service):


Server activity is up this month. I purchased 18 new magic instruction DVDs at Magic Live for \$5 each. What a great deal. I wish I had bought more.

This brings our magic audiobooks collection up to 602, our magic instruction videos (not digitized yet) up to 1,688, and our magic movies up to 86. Not everything has been put on the server yet but is in process.

- TV Category in red (Magic TV Shows)
- Music Category in blue (Magic Audiobooks, Magic Music, & Magic Podcasts)
- Photos Category in orange (Ring 76 Photos and Videos)


Red Magician by Lisa Goldstein

August 26th, 2024

The meeting started promptly at 7 pm.

Mike Stilwell laid out the plans for the Ring entertainment for the rest of the year and the early part of 2025 (See What's Coming Up pg 2).

The changes in the Parking situation are important and the Ring will be reminded that the lot will now just be for drop-offs. (See Parking pg 2) The rest of the lot is restricted for Church business.

Next up was New Business. Treasurer Miguel Garcia reported that the fictitious name statement needed for the Ring business was finalized with public publication. Dues are still coming in though late fees are in effect and dues are \$35 if you have yet to pay.

Mark Booth had no information as the last meeting was canceled due to an increase in Covid cases.

James Thayer reported that the current paid membership is sixty-eight members in good standing as of this date with seventy-nine members on our roster. Some of those members have not yet paid dues.

Gary Salisbury gave his library report. DVDs were purchased at Magic Live and black cases for new DVDs in the physical library were also per cured. Six hundred auto books are currently on the library Plex server, with 1600 instructional DVDs and performance DVDS totaling over 1500.

President Josh Sherwin was selected as Commander in the Chaplin Corps, United States Navy.

San Diego Magician's Facebook page is a good place to post information on Ring meetings. Mark Booth volunteered to give them information on the upcoming Swap Meet.
