## Michael Johnson Offers Life Skills Magic Program

Ring 76 member **Michael Johnson** is sharing his new Life Skills Magic program at birthday parties and after-school programs throughout

Southern California. In December 2024, he brought his show to San Diego County, Riverside County and Orange County. In February 2025 he performs for all the schools in the San Jacinto School District for the second year in a row. His program is one-third show, one-third sharing, and one-third teaching.

Michael started Life Skills Magic as a way to expand his traditional family magic show, with more interactive activities. For example, he lets kids examine his collection of magic wands. He passes out magic magazines. He also brings the World's Smallest Magic Shop for

kids to check out a dazzling miniature display. Some of the tricks he teaches involve pencils, rope, ping pong balls, and coins. "I think kids are too intelligent today just to sit and watch," he said. "I like to share my magic joy in multiple ways, as a magician, a collector, and a storyteller. I sure am learning a lot in this new format!"



# **Ex** Libris

Welcome to Ex Libris, my monthly newsletter article about the IBM Ring 76 Library in San Diego, CA.

'Ex Libris' (Eh-cks LEE-breese), means 'From the Book'. Generally, you will see this term used on bookplates to denote that it came from the library of its owner. For example: "Ex Libris: Gary Salisbury" is on all my personal books.

This is where we talk about your library as well as do book and video reviews. Yes, your library! If you are a Ring 76 member in good standing, then this is your library! So be sure to stay in good standing by paying your dues on time.

Someone recently asked me, "What is the Ring 76 Library?" I responded, "It is currently over 1,000 volumes of magic books and magazines, all available for check-out. It is 744 magic audiobooks, 1,741 magic instruction videos, 92 full length magic movies, 10 albums of magic music (some royalty free), 1,526 magic performance videos (many classics), 10 podcasts (over 2,000 episodes that we co-host), 23 magic TV series, a photo warehouse (where we will save all our Ring 76 activity photos) and all this is available for streaming from the Ring 76 Magic Media Server.

It is also a museum for a collection of historic Ring 76 memorabilia from one of our founders, Honest Sid Gerhart. It is a magical learning source unparalleled in the entire IBM organization and it is funded totally from donations and fundraising efforts that I have engaged in on your behalf."



(If you do not hear back from me within 24 hours, there may have been a technical problem so call me.) I will make sure the item(s) get to the next monthly meeting or you can pick it up at my home in Blossom Valley.

There is a limit of 4 items per month. You will need to sign the library card attached to the item along with your phone number. We ask that you return the items to the library on or before the monthly meeting for the following month (for example: If you check out a book at the July meeting, it should be returned on or before the August meeting). If need be, you can keep the book or video again if nobody else has requested it but you must sign for it again.

Our objective is to build the best magic reference library in the entire IBM organization world-wide but we need your help to do that. Please return overdue books & videos and donate regularly to your library. The library is here so YOU can learn how to perform magic. Use it! Am I doing a good job for you? Do I meet your needs? # Joint I.B.M. and S.A.M. Ethics Statement

The International Brotherhood of Magicians and the Society of American Magicians join in recommending that all magicians adhere to the following code of ethical conduct

- Oppose the willful exposure to the public of any principles of the Art of Magic or the method employed in any magic effect or illusion.
- Display ethical behavior in the presentation of magic to the public and in our conduct as magicians, including not interfering with or jeopardizing the performance of another magician, either through personal intervention or the unauthorized use of another's creation.
- Recognize and respect for rights of the creators, inventors, authors and owners of
  magic concepts, presentations, effect and literature, and their rights to have
  exclusive use of, or to grant permission for the use of by others of such creations.
- Discourage false and misleading statements in the advertising of effects and literature merchandise or actions pertaining to the magical arts.
- Discourage advertisement in magical publication for any magical apparatus, effect, literature of other materials for which the advertiser does not have commercial rights.
- Promote the humane treatment and care of livestock used in magical performances.

Each organization expects its members to adhere to the foregoing ethical principles and to educate non-members to the need to adhere to these ethical precepts.
