So, Ring 76 members, look around, look at your board, we have new blood that are trying their hand at helping our club be more successful.

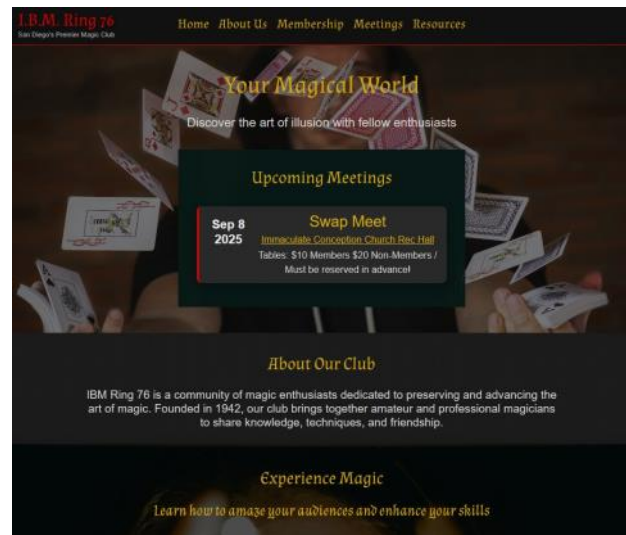

November we have a lecture on restaurant magic with Shawn McMaster - **Deceptive Dining**.

Shawn McMaster is a corporate entertainer who has performed all over the world. He has performed his brand of comedy magic in clubs, theaters, Las Vegas, Off-Broadway, cruise ships, and is a favorite at the Magic Castle in Hollywood. He has appeared on TV shows such as *Masters of Illusion* and *America's Got Talent*.

Shawn is also a writer of many books and articles on magicians and the art of magic that have appeared in numerous magic and mainstream publications. He was associate editor of *MAGIC Magazine* for three years and remained a contributing writer right up to its final issue. He was also the creator and editor of magic's first all-digital magic publication (yes, even before *Vanish Magazine*), entitled *The Mandala*.

Shawn McMaster has been working in the trenches making his sole living with magic for 33 years. During all that time, he has rarely been without at least one weekly restaurant gig. Early on, he was working two to three a week. These days, Shawn is a world traveler, working engagements and corporate events around the world, yet he still keeps a very successful presence within restaurants performing for patrons and making restaurant owners very happy with his work. His lecture *Deceptive Dining* is a highly-informative study on the business of restaurant magic. Not only the best type of effects to perform in a restaurant setting, but an in-depth and detailed blueprint of how to gain, keep, and profit from a regular restaurant magic gig taken from over three decades of real-world experience will be presented in this lecture. If you have ever thought about performing in restaurants of any kind, you cannot afford to miss this.

One thing to remember, Magic Live would not be very magical without you. After all, it is y(our) stories that will LIVE on.

Ex Libris

Welcome to Ex Libris, my monthly newsletter article about the IBM Ring 76 Library in San Diego, CA.

'Ex Libris' (Eh-cks LEE-breese), means 'From the Book'. Generally, you will see this term used on bookplates to denote that it came from the library of its owner. For example: "*Ex Libris: Gary Salisbury*" is on all my personal books.

This is where we talk about your library as well as do book and video reviews. Yes, your library! If you are a Ring 76 member in good standing, then this is your library! So be sure to stay in good standing by paying your dues on time.

Someone recently asked me, "*What is the Ring 76 Library?*" I responded, "It is a collection of magic books and magazines, all available for check-out. It is a collection of magic themed audiobooks, magic instruction videos, magic movies, albums of magic music (some royalty free), a collection of public domain magic performance videos (many classics), a collection of magic podcasts that we co-host, magic TV series, a photo warehouse (where we will save all our Ring 76 activity photos) and all this is available for streaming from the *Ring 76 Magic Media Server*.

It is also a museum for a collection of historic Ring 76 memorabilia from one of our founders, Honest Sid Gerhart. It is a magical learning source unparalleled in the entire IBM organization and it is funded totally from donations and fundraising efforts that I have engaged in on your behalf."

Recently we heard a rumor from a non-member that we were stealing videos and putting them on our server thereby robbing hard working magicians from money they deserve. We respond, "ABOSOLUTELY NOT!" We have a very strict policy against pirating any media where it be digital or printed. In fact, if you donate any merchandise that has even the slightest hint of illegality, we will politely refuse it. The only media on the server is media that we legally own.

It is our understanding that per the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) 1998, that you are legally allowed to make one back-up copy of any digital media you own. Our back-up copy is what we have on the *Magic Media Server*.

Streaming saves you from having to check out the physical media. You can stream the videos but not download them and the only exceptions to downloading, are the pictures and graphics in the *Ring 76 Photos & Videos* library.

As members of Ring 76, it is your job to defend the Ring against any slander. Perhaps the best way to deal with this in the future is to follow the rules of *Fight Club* and what's the 1st rule about *Fight Club*? *You don't talk about Fight Club*.

If anyone has any further questions about this, I am at your service.

WHAT'S NEW AT YOUR LIBRARY?

We need your DVD and VHS tape videos. They will be put on the *Ring 76 Magic Media Server* so you will still be able to watch them or check the physical media back out. Please help. Sharing is good! Sharing is fun!

Library Donations:

We received the following donations last month:

- Malcom Cambell's estate donated some books, DVDs and magic props, plus a lot of junk that has no real purpose other than the trash bin. The books have been put into the library, the DVDs are being put on the Magic Media Server, the props will be offered for sale at the next swap meet or used for door prizes.
- Greg Wausen donated a video, Dan Garrett-Kidshow Kon-niverery.
- Gary Salisbury donated 10 new boxes of playing cards which will be sold at the meetings.
- Dr. X donated more magic oriented audiobooks which have been put on the Magic Media Server.

We do have a recent promise of a retired non-member magician who will be donating his magic to the library for your benefit within the next few weeks (still waiting...)

Which brings up the subject of, "*What will happen to your magic after you do your final bow?*" If you would like all the members of your magic club to benefit from it, in your memory, then consider naming the *IBM Ring 76 Library* as the beneficiary of your magic. The library serves as the recipient of all donations for the club and will make sure you are remembered in passing.

This has to be in your will or trust, in order to be effective. If you tell your heirs that you want Ring 76 to receive it, that isn't good enough to guarantee it happening. Your heirs may decide to do as they wish, not as you wish.

As for myself, I specifically say in my trust that *IBM Ring 76 Library* will receive all my current magic library which is about 350 volumes. I had already donated my video library of over 300 videos to the library to get the Magic Media Server started.

The library needs to be fed in order to keep it alive, so your donations would be greatly appreciated. It's your library so please support it.

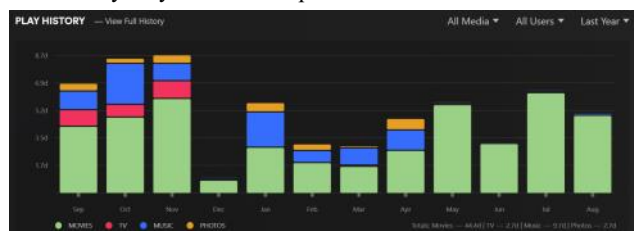
**Ring 76 Magic Media Server (Streaming Service):**

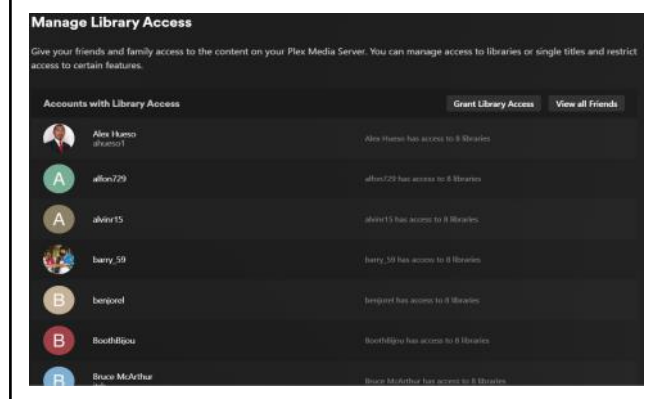
Plex only offers 4 categories:

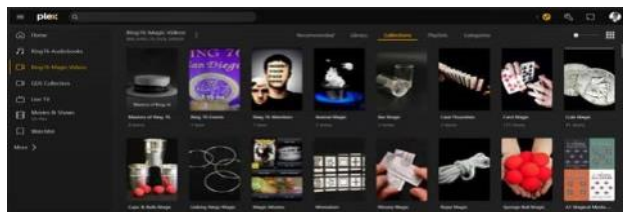
This magic machine is your key to *learning* and *being entertained*. It is a benefit from being a Ring 76 member so please make use of it.

Members may contact me 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, either by e-mail (at librarian@ring76.com) or by cell phone (voice or text) at 619-569-6035 to let me know what you would like to check out. (If you do not hear back from me within 24 hours, there may have been a technical problem so call me.) I will make sure the item(s) get to the next monthly meeting or you can pick it up at my home in Blossom Valley.

There is a limit of 4 items per month. You will need to sign the library card attached to the item along with your phone number. We ask that you return the items to the library on or before the monthly meeting for the following month (for example: If you check out a book at the July meeting, it should be returned on or before the August meeting). If need be, you can keep the book or video again if nobody else has requested it but you must sign for it again.

Our objective is to build the best magic reference library in the entire IBM organization world-wide but we need your help to do that. Please return over-due books & videos and donate regularly to your library. The library is here so YOU can learn how to perform magic. Use it! Am I doing a good job for you? Do I meet your needs? INSIGHT PRO BY HUGO SHELLY (NEW) - \$375

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Insight has evolved – featuring a new reader with the ability to detect three cards simultaneously! Retail for \$550 but is out of stock everywhere I have looked.

Insight Pro includes a deck of 52 electronic playing cards. Invisible RFID chips embedded in each card transmit the suit and value to the Insight reader, a miniature device that will quietly vibrate the value of the card, or send it to a nearby iPhone.

THE BASIC EFFECT:

The performer hands the deck to a volunteer and invites them to choose their favorite card, placing the rest of the deck aside. Without touching the volunteer or the deck, the performer reveals the chosen card. Included are seven incredible new routines by Colin McLeod and Mark Elsdon.

THE READER:

The reader features both wireless transmission and on-board vibration cuing. At only 77 x 33mm it's incredibly small, with a range that allows you to detect cards and tags with a single gesture. The battery will last for over 10 hours on a single charge and is both rechargeable and replaceable.

THE DECK

The Insight deck (Phoenix edition) is the very first electronic deck to be designed from the ground up specifically for magicians. The chips and antenna are embedded in the cards during the manufacturing process, ensuring that each card is perfectly thin and flat. The deck can be shuffled and handled in the same way as an ordinary deck, and is designed to last a lifetime.

- Dimensions: 77 x 33mm
- Battery life: 10 hours (rechargeable & replaceable)
- Range: 11cm from the Insight playing cards to the reader, 10m from the reader to a nearby iPhone.
- Includes: The reader, 52 electronic playing cards, Velcro wrist strap, instructions and routines.

TENYO T-174 CLYDE MAGIC RABBIT (UNUSED) - \$125



Ask a spectator to select a card from a deck, remember it, and place it back anywhere. Now this is where the magician traditionally tries to find the card. But not this time! Instead Clyde the magic rabbit will find it. Clyde is a wonderful idea, a great prop, and a guaranteed audience pleaser. This is a wonderful 'puppet' effect where the magician holds a stuffed bunny which appears to have a life of it's own. Several effects with this wonderful prop are suggested in the instructions including "card in carrot."

Even if you don't use this item for a magic act, it's a wonderful collectible item and also a great prop for puppeteers. Comes complete with original box.

The rabbit itself looks very nice and is of superb quality. When you use the rabbit as the instructions say, it really does look like it is alive – very well done by Tenyo and is now a sought after collector's item selling elsewhere in the \$200 range.

\$2.85 LOCKING COIN TRICK (JOHNSON) - \$40

For the connoisseur of fine magical apparatus. Same effect as The Locking Dollar Thirty-Five trick but using two silver dollars, a half dollar, quarter and a dime. Everything vanishes except for one silver dollar, and that can be examined with a magnifying glass. Easy to follow routine also included. *Missing the silver dollar bang ring.*

The magician produces four coins, two coins of dollar, a half-dollar one, a quarter and a dime. He puts one to one inside of his left hand, then he removes a dollar coin and opens the hand all the other coins will have disappeared.
