Terry Lunceford - Honorary Lifetime Member



Congratulations to Terry Lunceford, for being elected unanimously as an Honorary Lifetime Member at the September 8th Ring 76 meeting.

Terry Lunceford is one of the most famous, well-known Magicians from San Diego in the entire world. He has been involved in IBM Ring 76 since 1989, as a volunteer, a member, a performer, a teacher, a mentor and an officer. In 2002 he organized a showcase performance of IBM Ring 76 members for the International

Brotherhood of Magicians convention in San Diego. From 2007-2009, he served as President of the club in Jack White's Magic Clubhouse. More recently, he won Performer of the Year in 2016, along with Close-up Contest Winner and Stage Contest Winner, for his performances at club meetings in Old Town.

For five decades, Terry has distinguished himself as a masterful showman within the world of Magic. He has been performing and lecturing at the Magic Castle in Hollywood. He has also lectured for the Magic Circle in England. Terry has headlined at Caesar's Empire in Las Vegas, Wizard's in Japan, as well as at venues in San Diego such as The Magic Lounge, The Gathering, Prestige, and Mystique Dining. Terry has invented and sold several magic effects including "The Viper Snake Basket", "Six Card What?", "Pocket Cards" and "The Floating Finger Ring". In 2001, with magicians J.C. Wagner, Johnny and Pam Thompson and Pop Haydn, Terry produced "Terry's Magic Pub", the first pay-per-view televised magical event. Over the years, Terry has found time to also volunteer for charity events and donate magical effects to our club events, raffles and auctions.

Monday November 10th we have a lecture on restaurant magic with Shawn McMaster - Deceptive Dining.

Shawn McMaster is a corporate entertainer who has performed all over the world. He has performed his brand of comedy magic in clubs, theaters, Las Vegas, Off-Broadway, cruise ships, and is a favorite at the Magic Castle in Hollywood. He has appeared on TV shows such as *Masters of Illusion* and *America's Got Talent*.

Shawn is also a writer of many books and articles on magicians and the art of magic that have appeared in numerous magic and mainstream publications. He was associate editor of *MAGIC Magazine* for three years and remained a contributing writer right up to its final issue. He was also the creator and editor of magic's first all-digital magic publication (yes, even before *Vanish Magazine*), entitled *The Mandala*.

Shawn McMaster has been working in the trenches making his sole living with magic for 33 years. During all that time, he has rarely been without at least one weekly restaurant gig. Early on, he was working two to three a week. These days, Shawn is a world traveler, working engagements and corporate events around the world, yet he still keeps a very successful presence within restaurants performing for patrons and making restaurant owners very happy with his work. His lecture *Deceptive Dining* is a highly-informative study on the business of restaurant magic. Not only the best type of effects to perform in a restaurant setting, but an indepth and detailed blueprint of how to gain, keep, and profit from a regular restaurant magic gig taken from over three decades of real-world experience will be presented in this lecture. Ex Libris

Welcome to Ex Libris, my monthly newsletter article about the IBM Ring 76 Library in San Diego, CA.

'Ex Libris' (Eh-cks LEE-breese), means 'From the Book'. Generally, you will see this term used on bookplates to denote that it came from the library of its owner. For example: "Ex Libris: Gary Salisbury" is on all my personal books.

This is where we talk about your library as well as do book and video reviews. Yes, your library! If you are a Ring 76 member in good standing, then this is your library! So be sure to stay in good standing by paying your dues on time.

Someone recently asked me, "What is the Ring 76 Library?" I responded, "It is a collection of magic books and magazines, all available for check-out. It is a collection of magic themed audiobooks, magic instruction videos, magic movies, albums of magic music (some royalty free), a collection of public domain magic performance videos (many classics), a collection of magic podcasts that we co-host, magic TV series, a photo warehouse (where we will save all our Ring 76 activity photos) and all this is available for streaming from the Ring 76 Magic Media Server.

It is also a museum for a collection of historic Ring 76 memorabilia from one of our founders, Honest Sid Gerhart. It is a magical learning source unparalleled in the entire IBM organization and it is funded totally from donations and fundraising efforts that I have engaged in on your behalf."

Recently we heard a rumor from a non-member that we were stealing videos and putting them on our server thereby robbing hard working magicians from money they deserve. We respond, "ABOSOLUTELY NOT!" We have a very strict policy against pirating any media where it be digital or printed. In fact, if you donate any merchandise that has even the slightest hint of illegality, we will politely refuse it. The only media on the server is media that we legally own.

It is our understanding that per the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) 1998, that you are legally allowed to make one back-up copy of any digital media you own. Our back-up copy is what we have on the *Magic Media Server*.

Streaming saves you from having to check out the physical media. You can stream the videos but not download them and the only exceptions to downloading, are the pictures and graphics in the *Ring 76 Photos & Videos* library.

As members of Ring 76, it is your job to defend the Ring against any slander. Perhaps the best way to deal with this in the future is to follow the rules of *Fight Club* and what's the 1st rule about *Fight Club*? *You don't talk about Fight Club*.

If anyone has any further questions about this, I am at your service.



in August. I have an additional 262 that have already been ripped but need some editing work. (Multiple files that need combined into a single file.) Volunteers, anyone?


Plex only offers 4 categories:

Members may contact me 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, either by e-mail (at <u>librarian@ring76.com</u>) or by cell phone (voice or text) at 619-569-6035 to let me know what you would like to check out. (If you do not hear back from me within 24 hours, there may have been a technical problem so call me.) I will make sure the item(s) get to the next monthly meeting or you can pick it up at my home in Blossom Valley.

There is a limit of 4 items per month. You will need to sign the library card attached to the item along with your phone number. We ask that you return the items to the library on or before the monthly meeting for the following month (for example: If you check out a book at the July meeting, it should be returned on or before the August meeting). If need be, you can keep the book or video again if nobody else has requested it but you must sign for it again.

Our objective is to build the best magic reference library in the entire IBM organization world-wide but we need your help to do that. Please return over-due books & videos and donate regularly to your library. The library is here so YOU can learn how to perform magic. Use it! Am I doing a good job for you? Do I meet your needs? INSIGHT PRO BY HUGO SHELLY (NEW) - \$350

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Insight has evolved – featuring a new reader with the ability to detect three cards simultaneously! Retail for \$550 but is out of stock everywhere I have looked.

Insight Pro includes a deck of 52 electronic playing cards. Invisible RFID chips embedded in each card transmit the suit and value to the Insight reader, a miniature device that will quietly vibrate the value of the card, or send it to a nearby iPhone.

THE BASIC EFFECT:

The performer hands the deck to a volunteer and invites them to choose their favorite card, placing the rest of the deck aside. Without touching the volunteer or the deck, the performer reveals the chosen card. Included are seven incredible new routines by Colin Mcleod and Mark Elsdon.

THE READER:

The reader features both wireless transmission and on-board vibration cuing. At only 77×33 mm it's incredibly small, with a range that allows you to detect cards and tags with a single gesture. The battery will last for over 10 hours on a single charge and is both rechargeable and replaceable.

THE DECK

The Insight deck (Phoenix edition) is the very first electronic deck to be designed from the ground up specifically for magicians. The chips and antenna are embedded in the cards during the manufacturing process, ensuring that each card is perfectly thin and flat. The deck can be shuffled and handled in the same way as an ordinary deck, and is designed to last a lifetime.
