
After dinner, Librarian Gary Salisbury directed a delight "white elephant" party activity. We all had fun watching the table-reps carefully chose or lose one of Gary's ten gift-bags of goodies.

The dining tables were cleared and the house lights lowered. Entertainment VP Paul Dwork introduced the star of the night's entertainment: a one-hour/two-act stage show by Los Angeles-based magician Steve Owens.



For Act 1, Steve performed visually-stunning "silent" routines. He masterfully manipulated colorful flowers, silks and balls, lit candles and cigarettes, ribbons and ropes, and playing cards. His routines included "Ball Manipulation", "Card-Frame Transposition", "Fountain of Silks from Newspaper" and "The Diminishing Deck". He also tore-and-restored a picture postcard.

For Act 2, Steve performed his signature "Shadow Act" which we watched in awe as he formed recognizable shapes on a backlit scrim. To music and sound effects, by using only the shadows of his hands, Steve created images of land and marine animals, human figures, action heroes and the profiles of familiar faces. His "shadowgraphy" deserved the applause that we gave him during our 3-minute standing ovation!

Welcome to Ex Libris, my monthly newsletter article about the IBM Ring 76 Library in San Diego, CA.

‘Ex Libris’ (Eh-cks LEE-breese), means ‘From the Book’. Generally, you will see this term used on bookplates to denote that it came from the library of its owner. For example: “*Ex Libris: Gary Salisbury*” is on all my personal books.

This is where we talk about your library as well as do book and video reviews. Yes, your library! If you are a Ring 76 member in good standing, then this is your library! So be sure to stay in good standing by paying your dues on time.

Someone recently asked me, “*What is the Ring 76 Library?*” I responded, “It is a collection of magic books and magazines, all available for check-out. It is a collection of magic themed audiobooks, magic instruction videos, magic movies, albums of magic music (some royalty free), a collection of public domain magic performance videos (many classics), a collection of magic podcasts that we co-host, magic TV series, a magic photo warehouse (where we will save all our Ring 76 activity photos) and all this is available for streaming from the *Ring 76 Magic Media Server*.

It is also a museum for a collection of historic Ring 76 memorabilia from one of our founders, Honest Sid Gerhart. It is a magical learning source unparalleled in the entire IBM organization and it is funded totally from donations and fundraising efforts that I have engaged in on your behalf.”

Magical Arts Library (Books):

We did not purchase any printed books this month. We currently have 5 book out on loan and 3 pending. Remember to return your books when your loan period is up because there may be someone else waiting for them or extend it for another month by notifying me.

Magic Media Server (Streaming Service):

I am still working on restoring the broken Audiobooks Library. I have restored 154 files with 987 to go. I also have about 250 video files that need video editing work before putting on the server. Volunteers are welcome.

TENOY T-174 CLYDE MAGIC RABBIT (UNUSED) - \$125

Ask a spectator to select a card from a deck, remember it, and place it back anywhere. Now this is where the magician traditionally tries to find the card. But not this time! Instead Clyde the magic rabbit will find it. Clyde is a wonderful idea, a great prop, and a guaranteed audience pleaser. This is a wonderful 'puppet' effect where the magician holds a stuffed bunny which appears to have a life of its own. Several effects with this wonderful prop are suggested in the instructions including "card in carrot."

Even if you don't use this item for a magic act, it's a wonderful collectible item and also a great prop for puppeteers. Comes complete with original box. The rabbit itself looks very nice and is of superb quality. When you use the rabbit as the instructions say, it really does look like it is alive – very well done by Tenyo and is now a sought after collector's item selling elsewhere in the \$200 range.


CARD-SHARK'S MARKED PHOENIX DECK (NEW) - \$20

Card-Shark meets Ted Lesley. This is a dream come true for all magicians who love to use a marked deck. The markings are based on the ideas of Ted Lesley, are extremely visual compared to all other marked decks on the market as they perfectly blend into the design of the Phoenix backs.



All markings are situated at the same spot right in the corner, so even the slightest opened fan will allow you to read the marking. If the back design gets into view, you will be able to spot the value. Can't get easier!

The printer is designed for a maximum duty cycle of 40,000 pages/month, for 5 years which is 2,400,000 pages. It does not have any problems. Laser printers are more durable and reliable than an ink jet printer with cheaper cost to operate. I wound up with two printers and only need one. Price is firm and price is low for a quick sale. **\$225!**
